Alkoomi Cabernet Sauvignon \$39.00 \$9.00
Frankland River: WA

Consistently one of the better WA cabernets. It shows rich, intense dark berry and cassis aromas with subtle charry French oak overtones.

Koonunga Hill Cabernet Sauvignon \$32.00 \$7.50
South Australia

This brand was launched in the mid seventies and since then has become one of our most favourite value for money wines.

Thomas Hyland Cabernet Sauvignon \$42.00
South Australia

The wine captures plum, mocha coffee and vanillin flavours. Excellent with Goat Curry and Garlic Naan.

CABERNET MERLOT

Vibrant, bright red with a purple hue. Raspberry, plum and spice aromas form a fruit driven nose. Have it with a lamb rogan josh Gosht Saagwalla or Lamb Vindaloo.

SPARKLING

CHARDONNAY

- Evans and Tate** \$36.00 \$8.00
Margaret River, WA
 It has a sultry cinnamon character on the nose, and stony, even limey flavours along with some white peach on the palate. It's a zesty structured wine. The palate has remarkable persistence and balance. Excellent with mild chicken curry and any seafood dish, particularly prawns.
- Capel Vale CV** \$36.00 \$8.00
Capel, WA
 There's a beautiful purity about this unwooded chardonnay. It's light bodied but still packs plenty of ripe melon and light white peach fruit in there. The palate is soft with a fine acid and nice sweet fruit flavours. Perfect wine for spicy food.

BLENDS

- Cape Mentelle Marmaduke** \$34.00 \$8.00
Margaret River, WA
 This is a beautiful medium bodied wine with a rich fruity palate delivering a mass of ripe plum and blackberry flavours, well balanced with understated oak. It has a soft velvety texture with fine tannins and an impressive finish. Nice with red meat curries.
- Evans and Tate Margaret River Classic** \$32.00 \$8.00
Margaret River, WA
 This has an impressive track record with a number of medals at national shows. A clever wine loaded with ripe fleshy fruit wrapped around a fine core of oak and fine tannins. It's great drinking with meat curry.

 Shiraz provides the backbone to this wine, with plenty of red berry flavours. Grenache adds a savoury, spicy edge. Tempranillo completes the package providing length and fine tannins, making it ideal with all foods.

PINOT NOIR

- Tin Cows** \$40.00 \$9.00
Yarra Valley, Victoria
 This comes from the Yarra Valley, where the cooler climate and fertile soils are ideal for producing quality pinot noir. It has supple silky texture with typical raspberry and slightly earthy characters. Lovely aromatics and a delicious fruit driven palate. Perfect partner to Indian food.
- Les Petite Vignettes Pinot Noir** \$45.00
Burgundy, France
 Sappy and bright, with sour cherries and a hint of animal and smoke. Very crisp and great with all curries.
- St Clair Pinot Noir** \$38.00 \$9.00
 This New Zealand pinot offers classic pinot character with a mix of subtle raspberry strawberry flavours and a little gaminess. Fine tannins and a little oak together with a fine acid sustain a long flavoursome palate. Perfect with Indian food.
